## Adopt a Horse from Indiana Horse Rescue

Indiana Horse Rescue takes in horses from different situations. Every horse that has come to Indiana Horse Rescue has their own story, some have a been treated very nicely in the past while others have had a very horrible past. Our policies are set to protect the horses, to make sure that they are taken care of for the rest of their days. Each individual that adopts a horse from Indiana Horse Rescue must become a member of Animal Protection Coalition, Inc., fill out our Adoption/Foster Application, submit two personal references, a veterinary reference, and photos of the facility where the adopted horse(s) will be kept. Once a horse is adopted, the new owner must send in an annual health report and recent photos of the adopted horse(s). The new owner may never sell or get rid of the horse(s), if for any reason the new owner can no longer utilize the horse or can no longer care for the horse(s), the horse(s) must come back to Indiana Horse Rescue. Although the new owner may not sell or get rid of the horse(s), Indiana Horse Rescue will transfer adoptions from the previous owner to a new owner, if that owner has gone through the application process and is an approved adopter.

**Mission Statement:**  
To provide a caring, loving, positive environment to those horses that have been either neglected, abused, abandoned, or are at risk of going to slaughter. We will place these horses in a positive and loving atmosphere that benefits both the horse and the adoptive family.

### What if the adopted horse isn't working out?

**We are horse people, we understand that horses will react to things differently in different environments. We want all adoptions to work out, so adopters have 30 days to "test drive" their adopted horse, if for any reason the adoption isn't going to work they can bring the horse back no questions asked. Adoption fees are nonrefundable, however the adopter may take up to 6 months to find a different horse that fits their needs and is within the same adoption fee range as their previous adopted horse. If the new horse's adoption fee is above the paid adoption fee range, the adopters must pay the difference. After 6 months if a horse is not chosen any adoption fees paid is considered a generous donation.**
