Indiana Horse Rescue began several years prior to incorporating. In 1998, the corporation was founded and they started attending slaughter auctions.

The rescue has since built up it's reputation as a haven for horses. We are always at capacity; with horses on a waiting list to come in. They come to the rescue in so many different ways: from Humane Societies, where they have been removed from the owner, or horses that require surgery or will no longer be able to be ridden. We also take in perfect horses that the owner cannot take when they move or have outgrown and from owners who want to make sure their horse does not end up on a dinner plate overseas. Every horse at the rescue is worked with to determine their best use and who would give them the best home. We find homes for these horses where they'll receive nothing but the best. They are then adopted out to the approved homes and monitored for the rest of their lives. Once a horse has been adopted, it cannot be sold or given away. The horse must be returned to the rescue should the new family no longer want, need, or be able to care for it.
